



JOHNS RIVER VALLEY CAMP is an outdoor ministry facility operated by a Board of Trustees for the Southern Conference of the United Church of Christ. **The camp itself is located about 18 miles west of Lenoir, North Carolina, at 6211 NC HWY 90, Collettsville** (*which is not the same as the business / mailing address*). The camp comprises approximately 280 acres of forest in a valley defined by the Johns River. It includes a one mile section of river, and bordered on two sides by Pisgah National Forest Land.

The camp location [6211 Hwy. 90, Collettsville] is different from business mailing address. [Please refer to detailed directions provided with reservation material or available on JRVC website. Note that some web map programs and GPS data do not accurately locate camp or Collettsville.] To reach the camp, take the Abington Road from the Ross & Co. CITCO / Convenience Store [1902 Harper Ave. NW; Lenoir, NC 28645 / [use Ross Store address for a GPS bearing], and follow the Abington Road until it ends at NC Route 90. Turn left, traveling west on Highway 90. The camp is 7 miles beyond Collettsville (NC 90 W) on the left.

CAMP DESCRIPTION and LOCATION

The **MAIN SITE** includes nine cabins (without bathrooms), two separate modern bathhouse facilities, a kitchen/dining hall, a recreation building, twelve camper hook-ups, two outdoor chapels, and Mt. Zion Cabin (which does have bathrooms). Bath, dining, and multi-purpose recreation room, and Mt. Zion Cabin are all handicap accessible. *[Clean-up policy: find clean and leave in like condition.]*

MT. ZION CABIN is at times available without booking the entire site. It is a self-contained unit in the Main Site which sleeps twelve in three bedrooms. The cabin has a kitchen, central common area, and two bathrooms.

The **BOGER SITE** consists of two modern living units (Shuford & Black). Each unit contains six adult friendly bedrooms (with private bath in each room). The living units also include kitchen and dining areas designed to accommodate the capacity of the buildings (20 - 24 persons / unit; diagram of building available). The Shuford Unit is fully accessible. An adjacent Abernethy Bridge Unit offers 900 square feet of program space, plus a small kitchen and bath. All three areas are equipped with central air heating and cooling systems. *[Clean-up policy: general pick-up; housekeeping services provided after departure. Optional linen service is available; reserve in advance.]*

The **OUTPOST SITE** consists of four A-frame cabins, an activity shelter, a worship area, a covered cooking area, and latrines. The site is primitive, developed without drinking water or electricity.
