8:30 am - 5:00 pm: (Travel time and work camp experiences) Work teams are sized at six campers [+ / -] (plus adults). Teams rotate in the course of the week to experience a cross section of work projects.

Planners, in cooperation with various agencies and churches in the region, have identified projects to improve homes (i.e. paint and repair), work in thrift shops / food pantries, help elderly with lawn care / landscape maintenance, build trails, restore animal habitats, and perform river clean-ups.

Work projects in 2013 included an elderly woman's home in Blowing Rock [Resort Area Ministries], an AME church near Collettsville [Smokey Mountain Mental Health / Caldwell County], habitat restoration [Grandfather Mountain], F.A.R.M. Cafe [Feeding All, Regardless of Means], Hospitality House / Hunger Coalition [High Country], and a river clean-up [Wilson Creek].
